



What is Laser Hair Removal?

Laser Hair Removal is a comfortable and effective solution to unwanted hair. Our Laser Hair Removal treatment combines three wavelengths and cooling technology, and is suitable for all hair colours and skin types.

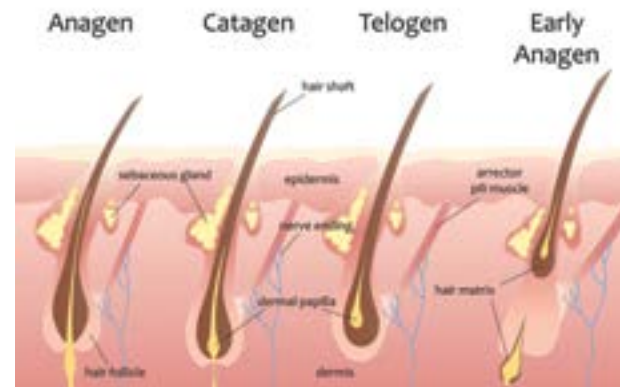
Unlike other methods of hair removal such as shaving and waxing, our Laser Hair Removal treatment targets hair follicles, preventing the growth of new hair. As a result of this, you can see long-lasting results from a course of treatments.

How does Laser Hair Removal work?

Laser Hair Removal relies on the process of 'photothermolysis'. The melanin in the hair strands absorb the laser light, which is then converted into heat. The heat destroys the hair strand and damages the follicle, stopping new hair from growing.

Our Laser Hair Removal treatment uses cooling technology, which ensures that the skin does not get too hot. Furthermore, by combining three wavelengths into one applicator, this gives us the ability to treat all hair colours and skin types safely.

While many of our clients experience great results from one session, we recommend a course of 6 to 8 sessions to see the best, long-lasting results.



Post-treatment care

It is normal to notice redness and tenderness in the area directly after the treatment. Generally, this will fade within a few days. Please follow the aftercare instructions below which will help you to get the most out of the treatment:

Apply soothing gel to the area for around 7 days after the treatment.

Avoid hot environments such as saunas and steam rooms for at least 24 hours after Laser Hair Removal. If you have a bath or a shower, make sure you use warm water. Do not use hot appliances for 24 hours after the treatment, and do not cook over a hot stove during this time.

Do not use deodorant on the area for at least 3 days following the treatment.

Try not to remove hair in the target area between treatments, unless this is done by shaving.

Avoid using scented lotions or perfumes, as this could irritate the skin.

Apply sun cream to the area for at least 4 weeks after each treatment.

You may apply make-up to the target area between treatments, but ensure that you remove this properly, and moisturise the area afterwards.

Post-treatment care (continued)

You must wait at least 30 minutes after the treatment before applying any make-up to the treated area.

If you notice blisters, let these heal naturally and do not pick at them. Apply dressing to the area if the blisters are painful or burst.

When will you see results?

You will be able to see results immediately after the Laser Hair Removal procedure. The majority of our clients see significant results after one treatment. However, for long-lasting results, we recommend a course of 6 to 8 Laser Hair Removal treatments.



FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

Is Laser Hair Removal painful?

Due to the fact that we use cooling technology during our Laser Hair Removal treatment, many of our clients find the treatment comfortable and painless. However, if you have sensitive skin, you may experience minimal discomfort during the treatment.

How many sessions do I need?

Our clients often see amazing results from only one session, yet we recommend that clients undergo a course of treatments for long-lasting results. This is because hair follicles need to be in their 'growth' phase in order to be damaged, and not all hair follicles go through this stage at the same time. Therefore, by undergoing more treatments, you will maximise the number of hair follicles that are targeted.

How far apart should the sessions be?

If you are treating the face, then you should wait around 4 to 6 weeks before undergoing another session of Laser Hair Removal. When treating areas of the body such as the legs and bikini line, you should wait around 6 to 12 weeks before your next session.

How long will it take me to recover?

Laser Hair Removal is a non-surgical treatment, which means that there is no downtime. As a result of this, you can go back to your daily activities immediately after the procedure.
